



Tuition Awards for Graduate Students

Central Michigan University offers three valuable tuition awards for graduate students, the Out-of-State Tuition Merit Award, the Neighboring Regions Tuition Award, and the Legacy Tuition Award. All three awards automatically grant in-state (Michigan resident) tuition rates for the *entire academic program* of any student admitted to a CMU graduate program; for the first two awards, resident status is contingent upon the student remaining in good academic standing. No application is required. In order to receive these valuable awards, students must meet the criteria shown below.

OUT-OF-STATE TUITION MERIT AWARD

*Available to students from any country or state who meet **all three** of the following requirements.*

-1-

GRE Verbal score of at least 560 and GRE quantitative score of at least 660

OR

GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test) score of at least 600

OR

MAT (Miller Analogy Test) score of at least 55

-2-

Cumulative undergraduate grade point average of at least 3.0 on the U.S. 4.0 scale

-3-

For non-native speakers of English

TOEFL score of at least 600 (250 cbt, 100 ibt)

OR

IELTS score of at least 7.5

NEIGHBORING REGIONS TUITION AWARD

Available only to students from the states or province listed below who meet the stated minimum cumulative undergraduate grade point average requirement.

Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, or Wisconsin: 3.3 cumulative undergraduate grade point average

Ontario: 3.0 cumulative undergraduate grade point average.

LEGACY TUITION AWARD

Individuals whose parents or grandparents received a degree from CMU pay in-state tuition rates. To be considered for the special tuition rate, prospective students should fill out the section of the admissions application that asks for their parents' or grandparent's names, Social Security numbers and dates of attendance at CMU.
