Using the "CMU PORTAL" system you can register for (Phase I) Spring classes from October 20 through November 19. For Drop & Add, available dates are January 8 through January 16. Using the "CMU PORTAL" system, you can register for (Phase II) classes from January 5 through January 8. Classes start on January 12 and end May 2 .

The deadline for dropping a class with a full cancellation of Tuition is January 16.

Please note, students taking ELI courses will be able to register in Phase II registration only.
